

# Vote for bicycle safety on Nov. 7

Four of the six incumbents and 15 of the 20 new candidates endorsed the Cambridge Bicycle Safety platform to build out the Cambridge bike plan on major streets in five years (see reverse).

We especially want to highlight the candidates endorsed by StreetsPAC MASS: Dennis Carlone, Jan Devereux, Marc McGovern, and Quinton Zondervan were endorsed as proven allies who consistently demonstrated leadership as Cambridge took steps to improve roads for vulnerable users.

Adriane Musgrave, Sumbul Siddiqui, and Vatsady Sivongxay were also endorsed as promising newcomers who show a deep understanding of the urgency of this safety issue and a commitment to infrastructure changes.

## Why vote?

The exciting progress we've seen on Cambridge St., Brattle St. and Mass. Ave. has met opposition. Electing councillors who champion bicycle safety is key to a safe, sustainable, and equitable transportation system.

## Why a protected network?

Our streets aren't safe for bicyclists or pedestrians:

- Since 2015, 3 cyclists and 2 pedestrians have died on Cambridge streets.
- First responders are called to a crash involving a bike and a vehicle every other day.

Building a protected bicycle network creates transportation equity by making cycling a safe option for everyone.

# Bicycle safety in the Nov. 7 Council Election

PLATFORM: I WILL VOTE for a municipal ordinance that requires the city to install at least 4 miles of pop-up protected bike lanes each year until the city-wide protected network is complete and to install permanent protected bike lanes when the streets specified as part of the city-wide protected network are reconstructed.
